RCL Parent Sideline Expectations:

If a parent (to include an adult relative, family friend, or guardian) from an RCL team receives a red card or is asked to leave a soccer game by a referee, that person is suspended for a minimum of three consecutive weekends without appeal. If the incident occurs within the last three games of the season, the suspension shall carry over to the following RCL season.

A second offense will suspend the parent from all matches for the remainder of the current season. If the second incident occurs within the last three games of the current season, an independent review by the RCL disciplinary committee shall determine the appropriate extension of the suspension into the following RCL season.

All parent or parent caused coach ejections shall be reported to the RCL commissioner by the club DOC. It is mandatory that the parent's club enforce this rule. The parent club shall notify the RCL commissioner at successful completion of suspension. If the RCL BOD or RCL Commissioner determines the club is not fully enforcing the suspension or a parent fails to comply, the RCL commissioner and BOD will conduct a review and take further sanction(s) against the parent's player, team and/or club.
